Participants: expert


- 1) The expert is new on the service and fills out the sign-up form by entering e-mail, birthday, residence and tax number.
- 2) The system sends a verification mail to the e-mail address.
- 3) The expert visits the verification link.
- 4) The system redirects to the profile page and asks for a cv.
- 5) The expert enters the cv and his skills. And confirms his information.
- 6) The system publishes his profile to the search mask.

Exit conditions:

The expert is correctly registered t the system and can be fount in the search mask.

Company Sign-up (1)

Participants: company (initiator), administrator

- 1) The company visits the website and wants to sign-in to the service.
- **2)** System requests for company name, e-mail and Tax Number.
- 3) Company submits its information.
- **4)** System verifies the company by sending a confirmation email to the given mail address.



Company Sign-up (2)


- 5) Company verifies the e-mail address by visiting the e-mail link.
- 6) System marks the company as verifies and informs the administrator to check the company's information
- **7)** The administrator verifies the tax number and all other information and sets the Company the accepted if there are no errors.
- 8) The System informs the company about their acceptance.

Exit condition:

The company has full access to the search functions of the service.



Company Sign-up (3)





Search for Candidates

Participants: company(initiator), expert/candidates

- 1) General search by field of expertise and skill selection (single candidate or group)
- 2) The company specifies the skills and their required knowledge.
- **3)** The system shows the results of the search for candidates ordered by suitability.
- 4) The company selects the interesting candidates.
- 5) The system sends a notification to the selected candidates
- 6) The expert answers to the request with yes, no or need more information

Entry condition:

All participants are registers on the system

Exit condition:

The company found candidates for the job offer for further communication.


