Confidentiality Agreement

The applicant is student or employee at the Technical University of Munich and applies to get access to confidential documents and information from the chair of Informatics 19 solely for educational and research purposes.

The recipient of information commits to:

- spend the same customary diligence and secrecy to protect the information from transfer, publication or distribution as he or she would for own confidential information which he or she would not like to see transferred, published or distributed;
- only use the confidential information for the agreed purpose, respectively for the benefit of the information provider;
- not distribute any information to third parties without previous written consent from the information provider.

The obligation for confidentiality remains after the period of work for the teaching or research project.

The recipient of information is entitled to forward confidential information if he or she is legally required to do so. However, he or she commits himself or herself to notify the information provider immediately, in order to allow the information provider to obtain an interim disposal against this obligation to transfer.

Changes or amendments of source code or documents made by the applicant may not violate property rights of third parties. Insofar, the applicant exempts TU Munich from all liabilities that arise from claims of third parties. The relevant copyright provisions do apply.

A violation of this agreement can lead to immediate revocation of access. The consequences shall be at the expense of the applicant.

Should individual terms of this agreement be ineffective or lose their effectiveness due to later circumstances, the legal effectiveness of the other provisions is not affected. The invalid contractual provision shall be replaced by an appropriate provision which comes as close as possible to what the information provider would have wanted. This also applies for the case that the agreement proofs to be incomplete.
